RABBI Leo Jung, in his letter of October 28th, 1925, enclosed a list of the schools of the Beth Jacob movement which is under the supervision of the Agudah Israel. It has schools in 45 cities with a very large number of pupils.

He also sent a budget for the Beth Jacob School from which it is noted that the total annual expenditures is \$67,650. -
the total annual income is - - - - - 28,670.
leaving a deficit of - - - - - \$38,980.
