IN OUR VOCATIONAL DEPARTMENT ARE BEING ADMITTED GIRLS WHO FINISHED ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. AFTER FOUR YEARS THEY GRADUATE AS SEAMSTRESS', TEACHERS FOR ARTS & CRAFTS OR TEACHERS FOR HOME ECONOMICS.
