Some nine or ten years ago, when you were a little girl, your pre-school teacher taught that the Ohel of Avrohom Ovinu had four doors, and that he excelled in the Mitzvah of Hachnosas Orchim. This does not mean that Avrohom considered this Mitzvah to be above all else, or that he neglected the other commandments. Quite the contrary, the Gemora states that our forefathers were mekayeim the Torah long before it was given. Avrohom Ovinu simply chose one Mitzvah as a lesson and a means to enhance his entire way of life, thereby reaching the highest shleimus.

Your eighth grade in Bais Yaakov has made, we hope, a lasting impact. We too, have chosen to emphasize and improve upon one particular Mitzvah, one of paramount importance in our daily lives. Sadly, because of our exposure to a rapidly deteriorating secular world, this Mitzvah is taken lightly and often neglected. We hope that by stressing the importance of this Chomur Shebechamuros, that the Rambam calls a Mitzvas Asei Gedola, you will reach ever greater heights of shleimus as a Bas Yisroel and you will be viewed with admiration, pride and Nachas.

We have attempted in this year-long project to create an awareness and impress upon you, our dear children, that honor and reverence for one's parents, grandparents, elders, and teachers is not subject to one's mood, nature or individual attitude. 
Dear Ima and Abba,

The heart and the symbol of America they did ruin, So now the Americans are singing the same tune. The Americans are sending bombs galore, And the Afghanis are threatened like never before



#### **NIGHT**




#### GREEN
